Preparing for Treatment

- Do not throw away or move furniture.
- Strip all linens from the bed.
- Vacuum and clean all areas to be treated –no clutter.
- Stuffed animals can be put in the dryer and in sealed containers or bags until no bugs are seen for 30 days.
- No persons on site for at least 4 hours after first treatment, 2 hours after follow-up.
- Do not use alcohol or over-the-counter products.
- Pillows and comforters can and will harbor infestation.
- These items can be dried on hot for 20 mins once per week. -If you notice spotting on pillows wash in hot water, then air dry, then put them in the dryer.
- After your home has been treated.... Expect to see movement or activity for the next 5-7 days... This is normal.

Bed Bug Treatment FAQs

- How long does treatment typically take to resolve a bed bug issue?** 1-2 spray treatments or 45 days minimum for light to moderate infestations & 3-6 spray treatments or 2-4 months minimum on heavy infestations.
- Should I dispose of my furniture?** No, throwing away the furniture risks spreading infestation and adds an additional 30 days of time to the original treatment plan.
- What if my room has no furniture in it?** If you don't have furniture in the room and there is nothing to treat in the room, the bed bugs will go dormant, and outlast the chemical treatment. It is recommended to leave furniture/belongings stationary throughout the treatment to ensure maximum effect from chemicals to pests. This also allows for shorter treatment times.
